ProMutual Group President and CEO Richard W. Brewer to Retire at End of Year

Boston, MA (April 4, 2011) – ProMutual Group, a leading provider of medical professional liability insurance, announces that President and CEO Richard W. Brewer will retire on December 31, 2011. On the date of his retirement, Mr. Brewer will have served in this role for 11 years. The ProMutual Group Board of Directors will conduct a search for a new president and CEO, with the timing of Mr. Brewer's announcement allowing for a process of orderly succession.

"It has been an honor to serve as president and chief executive officer for ProMutual Group over the past ten years," said Richard W. Brewer, president and CEO of ProMutual Group. "I feel fortunate to have been here during a time that allowed for successful and profitable expansion. I am grateful to the ProMutual Group staff, insureds and agents for their commitment, as the company's success during my tenure has certainly been the result of a team effort."

Mr. Brewer joined ProMutual Group in January of 2001, when the company predominantly wrote business in Massachusetts. He helped lead the transition of ProMutual Group into a larger, multi-regional company, particularly with the acquisition of FinCor Holdings, Inc. ("FinCor") in August of 2009, which doubled the number of states in which the company writes business. Throughout Mr. Brewer's tenure, the company also moved in rank from eleventh largest medical professional liability insurer in the country to seventh; as well as into the top three in surplus and assets. ProMutual Group is now a coast-to-coast company with a significantly increased presence in the hospital market.

"I speak for myself and the entire Board when I say it has been a distinct pleasure both personally and professionally to have been associated with Mr. Brewer and to have had him as our chief executive officer over the last decade," said Kenneth A. Heisler, M.D., FACS, chairman of the Board of Directors for ProMutual Group. "During Mr. Brewer's tenure he has guided ProMutual through important changes in the industry and a major acquisition.
